User Guide

The Edgr is a high powered, precision tool. Use it with care!

Avoid all maintenance while the unit is plugged in.

Do not drop or mis-handle the unit as it can become misaligned.

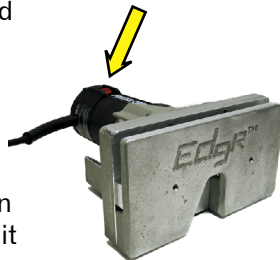
This user guide includes basic maintenance & re-alignment instructions.

1. Remove the Edgr from the box and place it on a rigid flat surface. The unit has rubber anti skid pads to keep it from sliding.

2. Ensure the switch is in the off position then plug the power cord into a 115 volt supply.

3. Turn the unit on. It is not necessary to hold it down. Its own weight will keep it in place while it is running.

Power switch

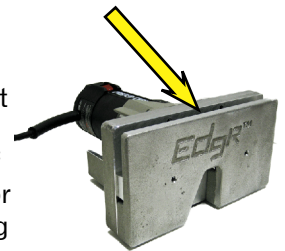


Keep groove clean!

Remember

This is a precision device and the slightest debris can have an effect on the finish cut.

Keep the groove clean and free of debris. We recommend blowing or vacuuming out after use or wiping with a small brush.



4. Using two hands, grasp a scraper firmly across the top edge.

5. Place the scraper in the guide slot and slide it horizontally in the direction shown with a slight down pressure. Use a slow and steady feed rate while maintaining a firm grip on the scraper. One pass should take about 2-3 seconds. Once you get the hang of it you can try it with one hand.

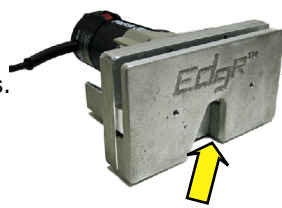


Scraper Sharpening FAQ's

- Excessive ridges on the cut surface indicate the feed rate is too fast.
- Debris stuck on the cut surface indicates the feed rate is too slow, which can cause the shavings to melt to the scraper.
- Debris on the cut surface can also indicate the groove needs to be cleaned or even the cutter. See the cleaning instructions to properly clean the cutter.
- Avoid sharpening scrapers with excessive wax buildup. Scrape them off on the side of the guide block to avoid having to clean the sharpener.
- If you drop the tool it can become mis-aligned. The guide ways can be readjusted with a true bar and shim stock. Contact us to review the procedure. Be patient it can be fixed!

Caution

The exhaust port for the cutter is in the center of the guide. Keep this area clean and free of debris. Do not put your finger or other items inside the port. We highly recommend using a vacuum to clean up after using.
